### **ANY UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE STUDENT IS ELIGIBLE TO SUBMIT!**

The Association of Criminal Justice Research (California) invites submissions of 10-page papers to be considered for its Student Presentation Award. One top paper and up to three runner-up papers will be selected. Content must provide an in-depth analysis of any issue related to criminal justice. Papers can be based on research conducted by the student; an in-depth literature review; or a policy analysis. Top papers will be selected based on their contribution to criminal justice research or practice. Principal authors can be full-time or part-time students; co-authored papers must have students as the first two authors and not be collaborations with faculty or non-student professionals.

#### **Submission guidelines:**

10 page maximum (no exceptions), *not including* title page, tables, charts, and references

Double-spaced, 1" margins, 12 pt Times New Roman font

APA format for citations and references

Authored by the student or co-authored by more than one student
